#### SOME SIMPLE EXPRESSIONS YOU CAN USE SOUND MORE ITALIAN

- 1. Boh! Instead of saying "non lo so" (I don't know) say "Boh" and shrug your shoulders
- 2. Uffa! Say this when you're annoyed or confused
- 3. Allora... Use this to change the topic or make a rebuttal. It means, so/ well then/ in that case
- 4. Be! This is short for bene and is similar to the English "well" and is used when giving your opinion
- 5. Ehm or Eh... Use one of these to indicate that you are thinking instead of the English "hmm" or 'mmm"
- 6. Mah When you're not sure about something use "Mah" to mean "Who knows?"
- 7. Ehi! When you see someone, you know well use "Ehi!" to greet them. This is the Italian version of "Hey!" or "Yo!"


